Artificial Intelligence (AI) is a field of computer science that aims to create intelligent machines capable of performing tasks that normally require human intelligence. The origins of AI can be traced back to the mid-20th century when researchers began to explore the possibility of creating machines that could learn and reason like humans.

One of the earliest examples of AI was the development of the "Turing Test" by British mathematician and computer scientist, Alan Turing. The test was designed to determine whether or not a machine could exhibit intelligent behaviour equivalent to or indistinguishable from that of a human. The test involved a human judge who would engage in a natural language conversation with both a human and a machine, without knowing which was which. If the judge could not reliably determine which was which, the machine was said to have passed the Turing Test.



Another significant milestone in the development of AI was the creation of the first neural network, known as the Perceptron, in the late 1950s by American psychologist Frank Rosenblatt. The Perceptron was capable of "learning" from experience by adjusting its own weights, making it an important precursor to modern machine learning algorithms.
